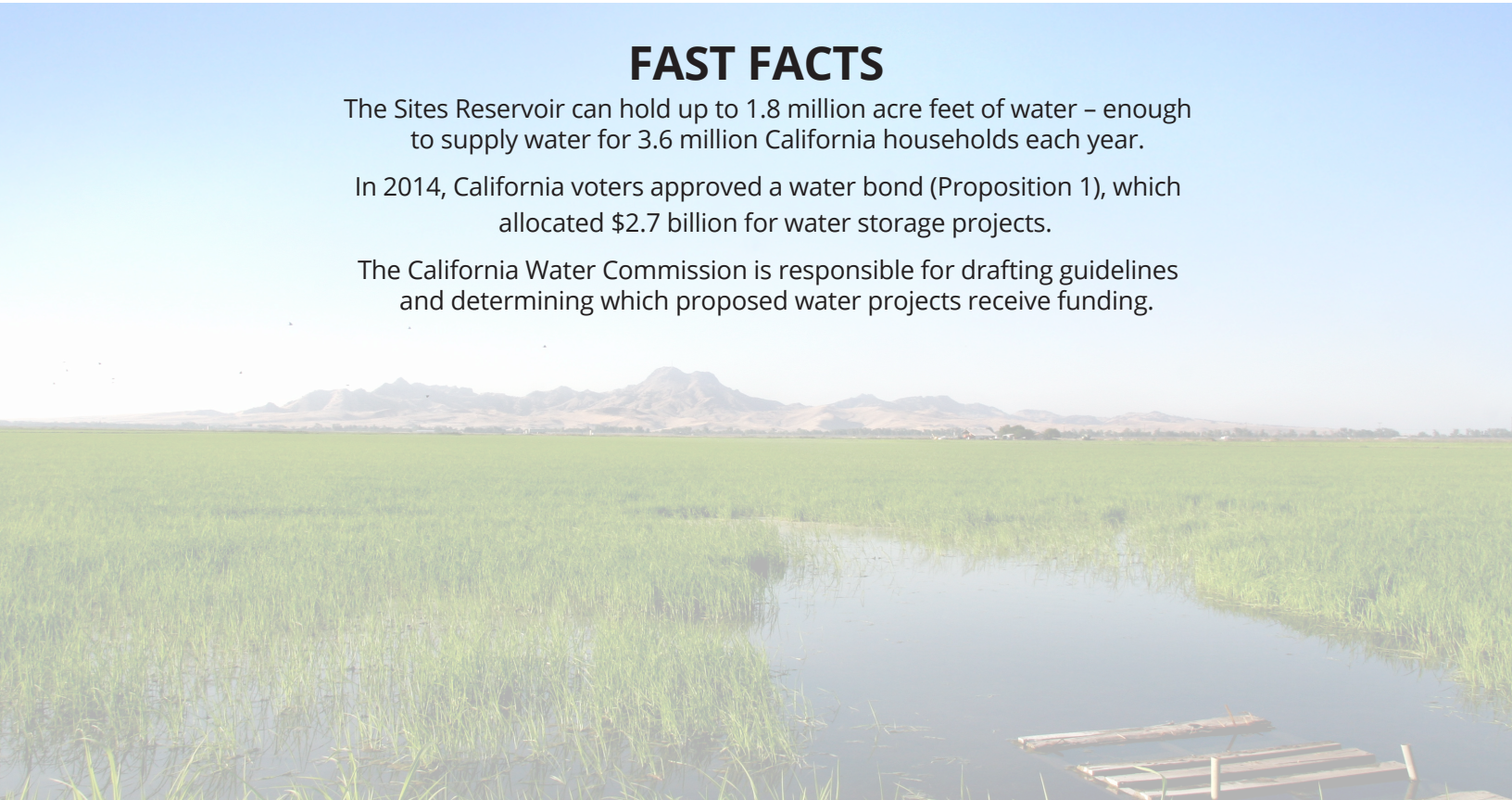

FAST FACTS

The Sites Reservoir can hold up to 1.8 million acre feet of water – enough to supply water for 3.6 million California households each year.

In 2014, California voters approved a water bond (Proposition 1), which allocated \$2.7 billion for water storage projects.

The California Water Commission is responsible for drafting guidelines and determining which proposed water projects receive funding.
