##### **Treasurer's Report:**

- FF: \$1545.08—Chris submitted oral and written reports.
- WP: \$844.33—\$27 reimbursement for prior storage fees. After further discussions and agreement, Chris (FFNA) will submit payment for current invoice for next 6 months; WestPark will pay for next 6 months, and continue to rotate back and forth.

##### **Planning Committee: Loren Cook**

- Pedestrian Bridge across Kaseberg Creek being put in west of Fiddymment Road, south of Cumberland. Will connect Roseville Trail System.
- F-51 park by Riego Creek Elementary now open for community input (between Crawford and Holt, at the northeast corner of the Hayden/Crawford intersection).
- Plaza at Blue Oaks continues to be in progress; Raley's is the anchor. Buildings going up tentatively in June 2021.
