



Roseville Parkway Widening Project

Planning is underway for future widening of Roseville Parkway between the Gibson Drive and Creekside Ridge Drive intersections. Roadway improvements at the Pleasant Grove Boulevard intersection are also included. The project is currently in the design phase. Construction estimated to begin in 2024.

Planned improvements

As part of the City Council-approved Capital Improvement Plan, the project plans to:

- Widen Roseville Parkway from 3 lanes to 4 lanes in each direction.
 - The westbound direction will be widened between Creekside Ridge Drive and Gibson Drive (east).
 - The eastbound direction will be widened between Reserve Drive and Creekside Ridge Drive.
- Construct triple left-turn lanes on southbound Pleasant Grove Boulevard onto eastbound Roseville Parkway.
- Intersection improvements include modifications to existing traffic signals
- Construction of new lanes, sidewalks, curbs and gutters where necessary
- Updated signage and pavement striping along the route
- Necessary utility adjustments

Funding

This project is funded by fees paid by developers which are gradually collected as new areas are built. These fees fund phased improvements to meet our changing needs.
