    - Donuts and racing in many area on the edge of development
  - Homes continue to be built in Beat 7. This will eventually require additional Beat for coverage.
  - Lots of through traffic – Sacramento to Casino
  - Kids on dirt bikes – not a high priority with everything else going on and difficulty finding them. Best if a pattern on abuse/violation can be established and then report that for better response possibility.
  - Roseville has partnered with American River Trail Association for bike trail presence so may see them around in red shirts.
