**Roseville Police Department:** Traffic Officer M. Keck present

- Gave stats so far this year= 3,571 traffic stops;
  - Currently 7 positions in Traffic division; Traffic assignments are 3-5 years, and one ‘life’ assignment with extensive ‘collision’ training.
- Gave updates on descriptions between E-Bikes, pocket bikes, dirt bikes, etc. Loren has posted latest info chart from the City on bike and scooter issues on the FFNA website and shared on media sites.
- Sue inquired about closure of the Police Department’s front doors today; apparently there is a closing notice on the front door. Use alternative reporting on PD’s website feature to report non-emergency issues. 9-1-1 operators are still available for emergency dispatch items.

- **FFNA:** Chris submitted written Treasurer’s Report with balance of \$2,610.25 (no change from last month).

- Candidate’s Forum—September 17<sup>th</sup> 6:45 – 8:00 PM at Martha Riley Meeting Rooms; will be recorded and live-streamed.
- Danny gave updated stats on RCONA Spring Cleanup results: total collections of event at 4 sites: Saugstad, 2 Bridgeway events, and St. John’s: Final totals:
  - 1569 vehicles
  - 63 bins containing 126.84 tons of garbage
  - 13.95 tons of E-Waste
  - 3.26 tons of mattresses
  - 440 volunteer hours donated assisting with the event. Our thanks to all the volunteers who showed up, especially everyone at St. John’s event who responded and stayed during the pouring rain.
  - Jim Kidd and Melinda are leaving the Committee, Sue and Loren will finish out the review of 2024 and initiation of 2025 planning, but are not expecting to stay on the committee. New Cleanup Committee members are being sought; Danny

- RCONA updates to their website continue—Report any questions to Randy Schwartz and Charles Aquino (design editors). Ben & Will assist individual NAs with web updates for a fee.
- New Advertising Policy passed--mainly about spreading RCONA recognition and distribution of funds (see previous Sponsorship Policy); Maidu will hold upcoming events—Movie in the Park 6/27 and Pancake Breakfast on 6/15—both at Maidu Park.
- St John's Community events: Deacon mentioned that their recent Community Celebration was very successful, over 800 attendees.
- NNO Updates: See Danny's separate recap of NNO assignments as well
  - Aug.6 @ Festersen Park 5-8 event time; volunteer prep starts earlier;
  - NATW and RPD registrations completed; Draft flyer completed
  - Danny still to reach out to Food trucks; Loren seeking child ID kits through Public Safety Foundation funds.
  - Funding: Christina Faria said county funds are still available; yearly awards \$500-\$2,500 available—Danny will apply.
  - Booths: Sue has invited agencies and National Sponsor ADT (all no fees)
  - Other Booths & sponsors—Danny & Shauntae will recruit. Suggested increase of booth fee to \$50 not completed—we may need email vote quickly so we can proceed with sponsor invites, final flyer and promotions—need to get moving.
  - Inflatables—two possible sponsors for inflatables donations: Jessica (Shaun's Handyman—bounce house) and Ed (possible slide?). Sue will advise & coordinate further with them.
  - Activities: Will have usual kids' carnival area; plus new Obstacle Course for kids—Safety Theme described.
  - Entertainment—all requested to seek participants; Mad Skills Lab , West Park High cheerleaders (Shauntae), Mojo performers (Danny), DJ (Sue) suggestions for follow up.
  - Scott to check with McAnally if available and Masa Masa (new vendor?).
  - Student Volunteers—Recruitment letter to Chilton before school ended (Sue); Shauntae to high school;
  - Other volunteers—Ed/Loren/Sue not expected to attend (but Sue assisting with many pre-event duties). Use NA media to recruit other volunteers.
  - Refreshments—Bob will seek usual sponsor donations. Sue has new sponsor banner to display all ongoing and major donor logos.

- Westbrook expansion under way, possibly done by end of July
