Guests present: John Freitas (West Roseville), Christina Faria (Placer County BOS).

Roseville Police Department: Sgt.Mike Ryland present (Traffic Unit), reviewed:

- Traffic Unit currently has 6-7 officers, but hoping to expand with overtime grant funding beginning Oct. 1st.
- Made 4,072 traffic stops last year. Their unit covers major accidents, collision reports.
- They are dealing with current issues mainly related to illegal use of electric dirt bikes on streets—not allowed at any time.
- Working to move drag racing elements out of the West Roseville area.
- Pass along ‘scam’ warnings to people; most cannot be followed-up on because they initiate from foreign countries. Watch for porch pirates, report crimes caught on home security to police.

- 2 bounce houses were donated; many added features were successful. Danny suggested that any new features in future be those vendors presented and our members did not have to provide volunteers for. Suggested Gaming Truck (\$300?).
